1. Description

The Lakefest Flotilla is intended to be a more laid back, set of distance races on Friday and Saturday. You have the choice of competing on Friday and Saturday, or just on Saturday. These races are arranged to facilitate:

- Sailors that want to be part of Lakefest (the racing and the parties), but aren't interested in buoy racing.
- Sailors from the north and western marinas on Lake Texoma will have starting positions close to your home marina and race to Grandpappy marina, The Point, on Friday afternoon.
- For "non-Grandpappy Marina" skippers, we are accommodating a late check-in on Friday night, AFTER the first race.
- Sailors from Grandpappy marina will be given a course to race on Friday afternoon, starting and finishing at The Point.
- Saturday afternoon, everyone will start and finish at The Point, with a pursuit start (your starting time will be based on your boats handicap).
- Each race will each be approximately 2 to 4 hours in length.
- Given that sailors may be starting from locations all around Lake Texoma on Friday, we will hold the Skippers Meeting via conference call and send the Sailing Instructions via email.
- Paid registrants will receive complimentary guest slips at Grandpappy Marina.

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1. Competitors may enter Cruising class or Leisure class (In-mast furling main and/or draft/beam <= 39%), Boats will be handicapped based on PHRF rating for each boat. Typical PHRF data is listed on US Sailing's website: [US Sailing PHRF Data](http://US_Sailing_PHRF_Data) Total handicap is calculated based on data submitted on the event entry form.

3.2. A completed, online entry must be received by noon, Wednesday, April 13, 2011, [click here](#). No registrations will be accepted after noon, Wednesday, April 13, 2011.

4. Fees

4.1. The entry fee is \$60.00 for both Friday and Saturday, or \$45 for Saturday only. Registration represents a reservations for the race. Payment for entry and dinner tickets will be at Check-In via cash, check or credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express). No registration will be accepted after noon, Wednesday, April 13, 2011. No onsite registrations will be accepted. Slips are provided complimentary to all registered entrants.

4.2. Dinner tickets must be reserved prior to Wednesday, April 13, 2011, and must be paid for at check-in. Dinner tickets are \$20.00 for Friday, \$30.00 for Saturday. A combination ticket, good for both nights is \$40.00. Children, 12 and under, are \$12.50 per night. Dinner tickets will not be sold at the door on Friday or Saturday. 7.2. The racing area will be on Lake Texoma.

7.3. There will be multiple racecourses on Friday and a single course on Saturday.

8. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the RRS, will be used. Friday and Saturday will be scored separately.

9. Radio Communication

All boats must be equipped with a working VHF radio, either fixed or handheld to aid in race management communication.

10. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to top finishers in each class on Friday and Saturday, according to participation.
