

**Notice of Race**  
**Texoma Sailing Club, Denison, Texas**  
**2011 Tommy Wunderlick Memorial Classic**  
**Long Distance Race**  
**September 3, 2011**

**1. Rules**

This Race will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing.

**2. Eligibility and Entry**

**2.1.** The event is open to all sailboats with an overall length of 20 feet or greater.

**2.2.** Competitors may enter the Spinnaker Class, Cruising Sails or Leisure Class (roller furling main and/or draft/beam ratio of <= 39%). Boats will race with PHRF handicaps. Boats may be fleetted at the discretion of the organizing authority.

**3. Fees**

**3.1.** Registrations received prior to August 20<sup>th</sup> are eligible for an early registration fee is \$60 and \$55 with a current US Sailing membership. Register online at [www.texomasailing.org](http://www.texomasailing.org).

**3.2. Entries received after Aug 20<sup>st</sup> will be \$90.**

**3.3.** All entries are required to rent a Kattack boat tracker at \$30 for the event. The first 20 entries will receive their Kattack rental for free.

**3.4.** On the morning of Sun, Sept 4 at 9am, breakfast and “eye openers” are available for \$5.00 per person. **RSVPs for meals are required on entry form.**

**3.5. All fees will be collected at Skipper check-in.**

**4. Schedule**

**5. Sailing Instructions**

**5.1.** The race will be provided at the skippers' meetings.

**6. Venue**

**6.1.** The event site will be at Texoma Sailing Club, at Grandpappy Point Marina.

**6.2.** The racing area will be on Lake Texoma, with specific areas outlined at the Skippers' Meeting.

**7. Course**

**7.1.** The courses will be announced at the Skippers’ Meeting and provided with the sailing instructions; course lengths will be planned to allow all boats to finish by midnight Sat, 3. Approximate GPS coordinates of racing marks can be obtained on [www.texomasailing.org](http://www.texomasailing.org) and will be included with the sailing instructions. Boats have a choice of a Spinnaker course of approx 50 miles or an approx 50-mile course for all Cruising and Leisure classes. A time limit may be imposed.

**8. Prizes**

**8.1.** Awards will be given to top finishers per class, dependent on participation. The name of the skipper and first place boat in each class will also be inscribed on the Tommy Wunderlick Perpetual Trophy.

**9. Additional Requirements**

**9.1.** All boats must be equipped with a working VHF radio, either fixed or handheld, for use in hailing by the Race Committee, check-in during the race, and to aid in rescue. Working navigation lights must be displayed at all times during the race.
